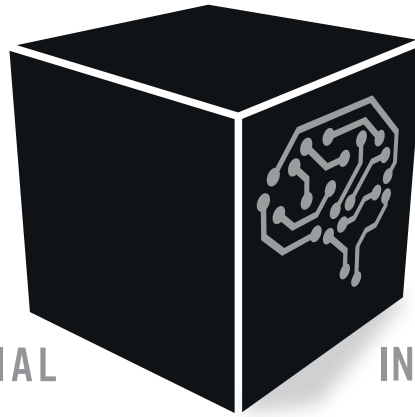




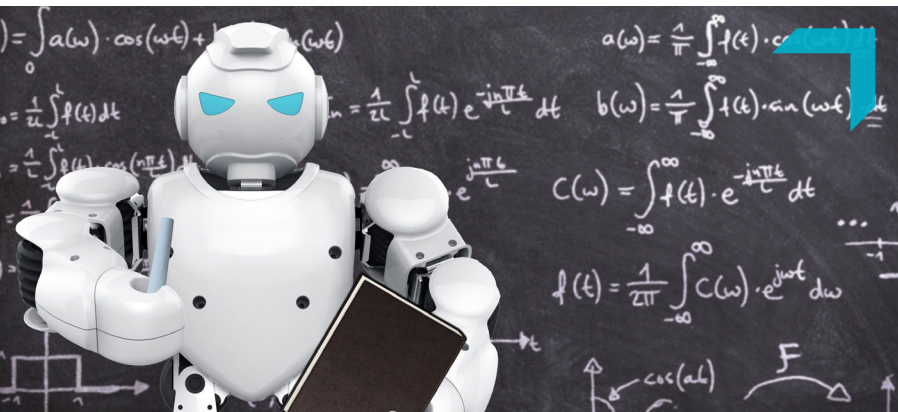

In the meantime you can watch this video: a great experiment of creating a neural network with inhabitants of a city: "Stillwell's brain".

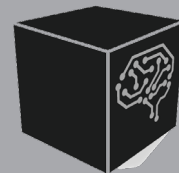
